

Accredited Supports to the Community (Healthy Families/PCAP): Home visitation support for new parents of children 0-6. Prevention services to prevent births of alcohol and drug exposed children. Reaching Home grant delivery for reducing homelessness.

Addiction & Mental Health: Information & referral to find the right service.

Addiction Helpline: Free 24/7 confidential service for support, information, and referrals for those experiencing addiction and mental health concerns, including problem gambling.

Alberta Government Rite Line: Toll free number to connect to provincial services.

Alberta Human Rights Commission: Provincial government commission to foster equality, reduce discrimination and resolve complaints of discrimination.

Alberta Supports: Provincial services for seniors, people with disabilities, job seekers, parents and families, homelessness, financial assistance, abuse and family violence.

Aquaplex: Hot tub and steam room, indoor & outdoor pool, swimming lessons, waterslide, diving board and a swinging rope.

Association of Communities Against Abuse (ACAA): Addressing sexual violence and other forms of trauma through treatment, support and education.

Badlands Community Facility (BCF): Commercial Kitchen, conference and wedding facilities, field house, indoor playground, fitness centre, classes and indoor running track.

Bedrock Playschool: Offers 3 and 4 year-old, half-day classes for children.

Big Country Primary Care Network: Free health workshops and activities to help you better manage your physical and mental health.

Block Buddies/Block Parties/Welcome Packs (Let's Connect): Support for residents and newcomers to build relationships and get information about local services.

Brooks & County Immigration Services (BCIS): Non-profit organization providing settlement and integration services to all immigrants and refugees.

Bullying Helpline: Free 24/7 helpline offering resources on bullying for parents, teachers, children, and youth.

Campus AB Central: Post-secondary learning opportunities in Drumheller.

Canadian Cancer Society: Toll-free helpline for people with cancer, their caregivers, and general public to answer questions.

Canadian Diabetes Association: Diabetes information and support.

Canadian Red Cross: Disaster assistance with food, shelter, and essential supplies.

Central Alberta FASD Network: Free services to persons impacted by Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder.

Child Abuse Hotline: To get help for children facing neglect, abuse or sexual exploitation.

Child Intervention Services: Intervention services for child abuse or neglect.

Childhelp National Child Abuse Hotline: Free 24/7 hotline for crisis intervention, information, and referrals in over 200 languages.

Children's Advocate: Individual and systemic advocacy for children and youth receiving provincial services.

Christ the Redeemer School Division: St. Anthony's School Catholic education K-12.

Citizens on Patrol: Community based crime prevention initiative.

Colton's Place: Family Violence Intervention Safe short-term no-fee housing for people in crisis due to family violence.

Community Development & Social Planning: (FCSS) Work with local organizations and community members to develop sustainable, locally-driven preventive initiatives that seek to enhance the well-being of individuals, families and the community.

Community Futures Big Country: Business loans, tools, and support for rural small business owners.

ConnecTeen: Free 24/7 confidential peer support service.

Credit Counselling Society: Free credit counselling, low-cost debt solutions, and education.

Crime Stoppers: Anonymously report information about crimes.

DARTS: Individualized support and opportunities for persons with developmental disabilities and special needs.

Drumheller Housing Administration (DHA): Management of local subsidized housing.

Distress Centre: Free 24/7 crisis support, professional counselling, youth peer support and referrals.

Drumheller & District Chamber of Commerce: Membership based not-for profit organization to build local business community.

Drumheller Associated Physicians Clinic: Family physicians and specialists providing health care services.

Drumheller Family Literacy Program: Building literacy from birth to 17.

Drumheller Health Centre: Healthcare services including 24/7 emergency department, continuing care, cancer centre, and public health.

Drumheller Public Library: Online and hardcopy resources, computers, musical instruments, walking poles, tool kits, maker kits.

Family Violence Info Line: Free 24/7 helpline for anyone experiencing family violence.

Fellowship Baptist Church: Parish Nurse, Freedom Session, Ignite Youth, and FBCKidz.

First Nations Health Consortium: Improve access to health, social and education services and supports to First Nations and Inuit Children living both on and off reserve.

Family Resource Network: Free programming for prevention and early Intervention services for families and youth ages 0-18 years.

Foster Parent Association: Support for foster and kinship families.

Girl Guides: Engaging girls aged 5-17 in outdoor adventure, financial literacy, mental health, advocacy and more.

Golden Hills School Division: Public School Division DVSS (grades 7-12), Greentree (grades K-6)

Good Food Box: Monthly fresh fruit and vegetables membership program.

Grace House: Rehabilitation and support for men addicted to alcohol/drugs.

Growing Families Society FASD Outreach: In home visitation program to support individuals pre and post pregnancy.

Happy Dinos Playcare: Nonprofit childcare centre in downtown Drumheller.

Health Link: Free 24/7 health advice.

Helping Hands Seniors Support: For hire services for companionship, light housekeeping, meal preparation and transportation.

Inform Alberta: Free directory for information about community, social and government services.

Jumpstart: Financial support for kids to participate in sport and recreation.

Junior Achievement: Youth program educating youth about financial literacy, work readiness and entrepreneurship.

Kids Help Phone: Free 24/7 mental health confidential support to young people in English and French.

Kidsport: Supports children who need financial assistance with sport registration fees and equipment costs.

Kinsmen: Service club to foster friendships and better the community and environment.

Lawyer Referral: Free legal services to people who financially qualify and who do not qualify for Legal Aid.

LGBTQ Support Help Line: Toll free 24/7 support & crisis line to support LGBT/sexual minority and questioning youth.

Lions Club: Global network of community service volunteers.

Little Explorers Daycare: Fully licensed daycare centre with out of school care, and a summer fun program.

Mental Health Help Line: Free 24/7 confidential line for support, information, and referrals for those with mental health concerns.

MH Enterprises: Employment services for career and training transitions.

Older Adult (55+) Services: Information services for pre-seniors, seniors, and their families. Computer assistance, tax program, art programs, toonie walks and more.

Outlink: Calgary based charity for support, education, and referrals for the 2SLGBTQIA+ and allied community.

Poison Centre: Free 24/7 confidential advice on poisons, chemicals, medicines, and herbal supplements.

Pregnancy Care Help Line: Free 24/7 support for those facing unexpected pregnancy.

Prairie Land School Division: Colonies of Hutterite Brethren, Delia (K-12), Morrin (K-12)

Project Reach: Mental health capacity building initiative in Prairie Land School Division.

Protective Services: Peace, Bylaw and Compliance Officers.

RCMP: non-emergency criminal records check, information, complaints, police certificates, and reporting crime.

Riverside Medical Clinic: Interprofessional healthcare clinic.

Rotary Club: Membership club taking action on local and global issues.

Royal Canadian Legion: Non-profit social organization and pub.

Rupert's Institute: Education, training and research to support Alberta Metis.

Salvation Army Food Bank: Food Hamper, bread sharing and community services.

Schizophrenia Society: Free programs for those with schizophrenia and their families.

Scouts: Co-ed programming for children aged 5-26.

Sea Cadets: Free program teaching youth 12-18 about seamanship, sailing, and traditions of the Royal Canadian Navy.

Service Canada: General information phone line for federal issues and services.

Sexual Assault Services: Toll free support for those recently sexually assaulted and those who have experienced sexual violence in the past. 9am – 9pm 170+ languages.

Starland County: County services.

STD & AIDS: Business hours answered by a nurse, otherwise recorded information.

Suicide Hotline: Free 24/7 crisis line operated by Wheatland Crisis Society.

Teenline: Peer Support

Time for Tots Family Dayhomes: Professional childcare in family setting.

Town of Drumheller: Municipal services.

Travel Drumheller: Non-profit destination marketing organization to encourage year round tourism in Drumheller Valley.

Turning Point: Harm Reduction supplies/education and drug poisoning response training.

Valley Bus Society: For hire transportation for seniors, persons needing mobility assistance, medical and special event charters.

Valley Veterinary Clinic: Veterinary services for animals of all sizes.

Volunteer Services: Volunteer coordination: volunteer, find volunteers, and volunteer training. "Volunteer Connector" newsletter and National Volunteer Week coordination.

Wheatland County Counselling: Private practice counselling and therapy.

Wheatland Crisis Society: Supporting individuals impacted by abuse through shelter, supportive counselling, resources and prevention services.

Youth Services: Programming and events to engage youth, grades 7-12, in the Drumheller Valley.

4H Clubs: A program for youth to build skills such as co-operation, leadership, critical thinking, public speaking and community service.
